Gun Cleaning Kit

The following is a list of equipment you may need for cleaning your rifle

- * Cleaning Rod 2 piece wooden rod, plus attachments normally including in the kit (bronze wire brush, wool brush, jag, worming tool)
- * Cleaning Cloth 2x4
- * Gun Oil, if in a spray bottom kept out of sight of public, ideally oil kept in either a glass jar or brass flask
- *Knapping Tool
- *Small wooden handle brush, I use a wooden butter brush I got from Sainsburys
- *Wooden handle screwdriver
- *Prick and brush which you will carry in the pouch on your sword belt.
